



Protection of personal data

Brussels Gay Sports VZW (here after abbreviated as BGS) attaches great importance to the protection of privacy and processes of personal data provided to it with the necessary care. Personal data are those data that allow us to identify you as a person, whether we actually do it or not.

Most of the information is available through the website without your having to provide any personal data. The personal data that you provide through the website in the context of a particular activity is processed carefully. This privacy statement describes how BGS handles the personal data that it processes.

Processing of personal data

The personal data you provide via this website are processed by BGS, Rue Marché au Charbon 42, 1000 Brussels. They are processed in accordance with the provisions of the European General Data Protection Regulation (EGDPR) of April 27 2016 (better known as general data Protection Regulation or 'GDPR'). BGS processes the personal data only for the purpose for which it is collected and only for as long as this is necessary. Subscriptions to e-newsletters are only included in the newsletters system and only for the e-newsletter for which the registration is made. Unsubscribe is always possible via a simple mail.

Transfer to third parties

BGS will only disclose your data to third parties if necessary for the purposes for which they were collected, namely the management of your membership and the proper functioning of our activities. They are in no way used for commercial purposes.

• language preference (French, English or Dutch).

Purposes

We process the above information for one or more of the following purposes:

- to process your registration of your membership,
- to communicate with you through the sending of electronic newsletters,
- to verify the minimum age of 16 years,
- to compile statistics.

Who gets and processes this data?

The data are processed in confidence by the board of Directors of BGS, as well as the activity leaders, the treasurer as the computer scientist.

Protection and preservation of personal data

We take all reasonable precautions to secure your personal information. The personal data is stored in a database on the server of OVH, which is also responsible for its protection.

Access and rights concerning personal data

As a member you obviously have the following rights:
